



GENERAL GUIDELINES

THE DIOCESE OF BARBADOS 200TH ANNIVERSARY LOGO COMPETITION

A) Introduction

In July 2024, the Anglican Diocese of Barbados will commemorate the 200th Anniversary of its establishment. With this celebration it is hoped that we bring renewed awareness to the significant contribution that this Diocese has played in the development of the religious, social, and economic landscape of Barbados while affording members of the Church and the wider community the opportunity to join in celebrating the rich heritage and tradition of Anglicanism as expressed in the Church in the Province of the West Indies. In this regard, the Diocese of Barbados 200th Anniversary Committee will launch the 200th Anniversary Logo Competition to commemorate the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the Anglican Diocese of Barbados on **June 1st, 2023**. The competition also aims to raise interest and actively engage members of Diocese in the celebration of the Diocese's Anniversary in a manner that encourages creativity, innovation, and learning.

B) Eligibility

Entrants must be member of a Parish in the Diocese of Barbados. Submission of entries to the Logo Competition must be accompanied by the signature of the Incumbent of their parish. Participants under the age of 18 must receive the consent of a parent or guardian. **(Entrants under the age of 18 are unable to enter a contract with the Diocese of Barbados.)*

C) Logo Topic



The topic should be a representation of any image (picture, drawing, etc.) that uniquely communicates the rich heritage and tradition of Anglicanism as expressed in the Church in the Diocese of Barbados.

The Logo must be in keeping with the Theme: *Celebrating 200 Years of the Mission and Ministry of The Anglican Diocese of Barbados.*

D) General Guidelines for Participation

1. The Logo Competition is open to all members of a Parish in the Diocese of Barbados.
2. Staff, Spouses and Children of the members of the Diocese of Barbados' 200th Anniversary Committee and/or the 200th Anniversary Logo Competition Committee **are not eligible** to enter the competition.
3. Logo entries must be submitted using the Entry Form provided on the Diocese of Barbados website: www.anglicanbb.com and showing the:
 - Full Name, age, telephone number(s) and email address of the applicant.
4. Entries missing any of the above information will not be considered.
5. Technical details and requirements of logo designs:
 - Logo design must be original
 - Logos must be submitted in jpeg format



- The technique used can be drawing, painting and/or computer design/graphic, the logo can be of any shape, but must be presented within a square frame of 6in x 6in, and must reflect the Theme for the 200th Anniversary celebration in its design.
- Logos should be submitted with a brief explanation in English of the design and the main ideas represented.

6. Submissions are to be made by individuals.

E) Submission

To be eligible for consideration, Logos must be submitted electronically using the Logo Competition Entry Form and signed by each entrant, or where that entrant is under the age of 18 years, signed by the parent or guardian of the entrant, with the accompanying signature of their Incumbent, to the email address: barbadosdiocese@gmail.com, no later than **31 July 2023**.

Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered.

F) Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on the appropriate use and effective portrayal of the theme; the attractiveness and distinctiveness of the design; as well as its functionality and readability.

G) Recognition of Logo Design Winner

In addition to the recognition and accolades at the Diocesan/National level, the winner of the Logo design competition will receive a cash prize of BDS\$1,500.00 (One Thousand Five Hundred Barbados Dollars) and the Anniversary Logo will be used on all official documentation and promotional items for the Anglican Diocese of Barbados' 200th Anniversary. The winner of the Logo competition will also be invited to a photo opportunity with the Bishop of the Diocese and will be featured on Diocese's social media platforms and printed materials.



H) Acceptance

Submission of an entry to this competition forms express consent and acceptance by each entrant that she/he has read and agrees to be bound by all stated guidelines, rules, terms, and conditions herein, and that the judges' decision is final.

I) Intellectual Property Rights

The Logo submitted must be unpublished and exclusively created for this competition.

Entrants give permission to the Diocesan Synod, the Diocesan Secretariat and The Diocese of Barbados 200th Anniversary Committee to use their submission in print and digital media for marketing and promotional purposes.

Each entrant accepts that all entries become the property of the Anglican Diocese of Barbados and copyright of or all intellectual property rights in the Logo will vest exclusively in the Anglican Diocese of Barbados. Thus, each entrant further understands that if her/his Logo is selected as the winning Logo, he/she will relinquish all claims, rights (including any moral rights), and benefits related to the display, modification, reproduction, publication, distribution, use, and other exploitations of the work, other than the prize awarded to the winning entry. Each entrant also affirms that the design submitted is her/his original work, has not been copied from others and does not violate the intellectual property rights of any other person or entity.

Where it is found that there is any breach of the foregoing stipulations, this will result in the automatic disqualification of the entry.



J) Terms and Conditions

By participating in The Diocese of Barbados 200th Anniversary Logo Competition, each entrant represents and warrants that s/he has read and agreed to be bound by The Diocese of Barbados 200th Anniversary Logo Competition General Guidelines. Each entrant agrees that her/his entry becomes the property of the Anglican Diocese of Barbados and the copyright and all intellectual property rights in the Logo shall be vested exclusively in the Anglican Diocese of Barbados. Thus, each entrant further understands that if her/his Logo is selected as the winning Logo, she/he will relinquish all claims, rights (including any moral rights), and benefits related to the display, modification, reproduction, publication, distribution, use, and other exploitations of the work, other than the prize awarded to the winning entry.
